

The Faculty of Protestant Theology at the Rheinische Friedrich-Wilhelms-Universität Bonn invites applications to the following position:

Professorship (W3) for Social Ethics

A starting date for this position of 1 April 2022 is anticipated.

The Faculty of Protestant Theology at the University of Bonn is committed to ongoing development of a profile in theological research that is relevant to the present and prepared to take intellectual risks. The faculty seeks a candidate for this position who is likewise committed and who is willing to contribute his or her expertise in research and teaching to new faculty and university-wide co-operations.

In addition to a doctorate and habilitation or equivalent scientific achievements in systematic theology with a focus on ethics, qualified candidates will possess the ability and willingness to represent the subject of systematic theology in teaching in its entire breadth, in all courses of study, and to do so in German as well as in English. The submission of a teaching concept with the application is expected.

In terms of research focus, it is expected that candidates will hold expertise in areas of applied ethics that hold high potential for interconnection beyond the Faculty of Protestant Theology. The ability and willingness to engage in interdisciplinary cooperation, especially in mathematics, the social-sciences and the life-sciences — all with connection to the transdisciplinary research areas (TRAs) of the University of Bonn — are required. Successful acquisition of third-party funding is expected; third-party funding already acquired should be outlined in detail in the application materials.

Requirements for employment are habilitation or equivalent scientific achievements according to § 36 Hochschulgesetz NRW.

The University of Bonn is committed to diversity and equal opportunity. It is certified as a family-friendly university and has a dual career service. Its goal is to increase the proportion of women in areas where women are underrepresented and to particularly promote their careers. It therefore strongly encourages applications from relevantly qualified women. Applications are handled in accordance with the State Equal Opportunity Act.
