The professorship is intended to represent teaching methodology in agricultural as well as nutrition and domestic sciences in research and teaching and develop own research projects in at least one of these areas. Teaching duties include teaching methodology courses at the bachelor and master level for the B.Ed. and M.Ed. Agrarwissenschaft an Berufskollegs, B.Ed. and M.Ed. Ernährungs- und Hauswirtschaftswissenschaft an Berufskollegs as well as the school internship semester.

We are looking for a dynamic personality who knows how to familiarize himself/herself with new, interdisciplinary fields of work and to establish cooperation with the other teaching methodology chairs, the educational sciences in the Bonn Center for Teacher Education (BZL), the Center for Practical Teacher Training (ZfsL) Bonn as well as with colleagues from the agricultural and nutrition sciences.

In addition to a relevant doctorate, publications in peer-reviewed journals are required. Experience in the implementation of competitive third-party funded projects is desirable.

Practical experience in teaching is expected, preferably proven by the second state examination. Experience in vocational education and in extracurricular fields of practice relevant to teaching methodology is advantageous.

The conditions of employment are according to §36 Hochschulgesetz NRW.
